Digital Society Committee

On January 19, 2023, we convened the first Digital Society Committee meeting
of the year. During this session, there was an agreement to update the Digital
Position Paper, and Edgars Milgravis was elected as the new Committee Chair.

- Recognizing the upcoming elections on March 5 and the subsequent formation
 of a new government in early April, the decision was made to update the paper
 and present it to the newly formed government. This approach allows us to
 compile all edits and produce a new policy paper by April for presentation to the

- On May 24, AmCham Digital Society Committee (DSC) released their new position paper on Digital Resilience (https://amcham.ee/amcham-digital-society-committee-presents-its-position-paper-on-digital-resilience/)
- On September 13, another Digital Committee meeting was held. Edgars Milgravis, the Committee Chair, suggested updating the Committee Position paper before meeting with Minister Tiit Riisalo. For the upcoming events in the next season, he recommended the NIS2 topic, which will come into force within one year.
- On October 3, AmCham Digital Society Committee had an online Meeting with The Minister of Economic Affairs and Information Technology Tiit Riisalo (https://amcham.ee/amcham-digital-society-committee-meeting-with-minister-of-economic-affairs-and-information-technology-tiit-riisalo/)

Talent Attraction, Retention, and Education Committee

On February 1, The American Chamber of Commerce in Estonia hosted its Pre-Election Debate at the Nordic Hotel Forum. During the session, participants discussed a range of topics, including education, concerns related to English-speaking talent, and Martin Lään expressed his intention to step down from his role as the committee chair. All meeting attendees agreed to organize a luncheon event with Minister of Education Kristina Kallas, inviting AmCham members and conducting a Q&A session afterward. Additionally, a follow-up with a scheduled position paper was planned, and exploration will be done to determine if any guidance can be offered. The appointment of the new Committee Chair was made, and Megan Riley was elected to fill the position.
- On November 15, 2023 Speaker Luncheon with Minister of Education

- On October 11, the AmCham Healthcare Committee held its Annual Healthcare Conference. The conference focused on Prioritizing Healthcare, Financing, and Their Impact on Estonia's Economy and Prosperity.
