SHORT BIOGRAPHY

Over the nearly 15 years I've been fortunate enough (most of the time) to live between Estonia and my home in the United States, I have spent much of that time actively involved with the American Chamber of Commerce in Estonia. It has been a joyful privilege to have played a small role in shaping the organization into what it is today, serving over the years from engaged member to Vice President. I have had the opportunity to work alongside a high-impact group of volunteer leaders who strive to be a thoughtful and practical support network for AmCham's CEO, Daria Sivovol, and for the broader membership.

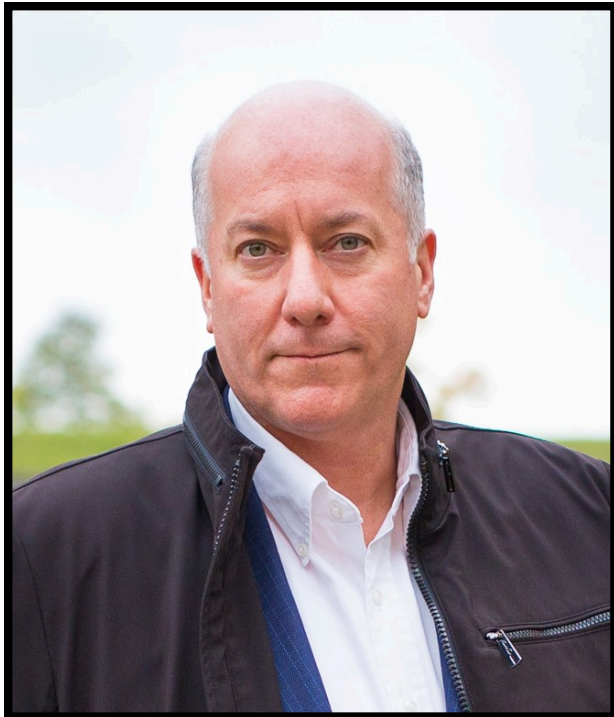


Indrek Laul

He is the current President of AmCham, having served multiple terms since 2017.



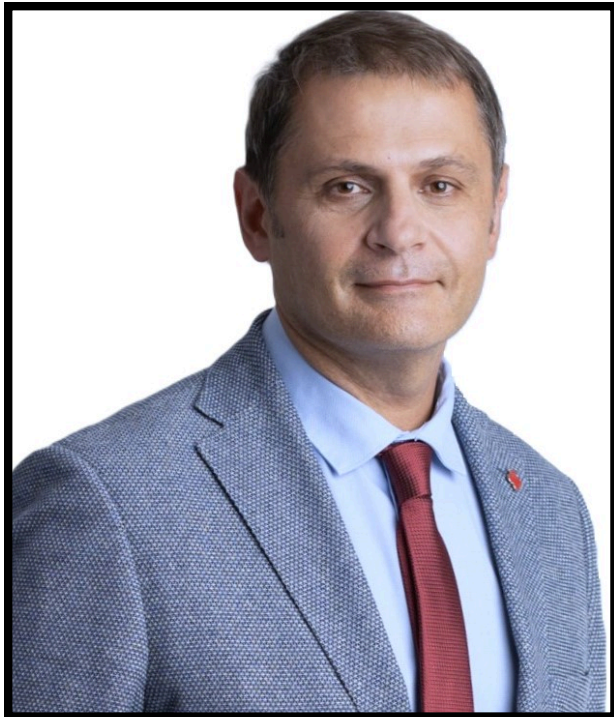
Greg Grace
